

Getting Started with Your iZone Climate Control System

Connecting your new iZone Control System, not previously registered to an owner, is the first step to unlocking a new level of comfort, so you can enjoy complete climate control and remote access from anywhere in the world.

Stage 1: Set Up the iZone Smart Hub

- 1 The Smart Hub includes 3 parts: Smart Hub, power supply and Ethernet cable (image).
- 2 Place the Smart Hub within 2m of a power outlet and 1m of a LAN port (e.g. on your Wi-Fi router or another Ethernet port).
- 3 Connect the blue Ethernet cable from the Smart Hub's ETHERNET port to a router's LAN/Ethernet port (not the WAN port).
- 4 Power on the Smart Hub. The LEDs will start flashing.
- 5 After a few seconds, the Globe LED should remain lit, confirming connection to the iZone Cloud server. If it is not lit, check that your router is connected to the internet and working.
- 6 Ensure the Climate LED is illuminated. This indicates that the Smart Hub is communicating properly with your air conditioning unit (CPU) in your roof space.

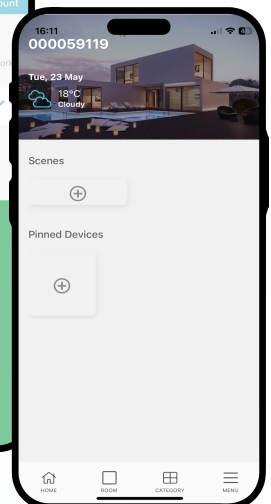
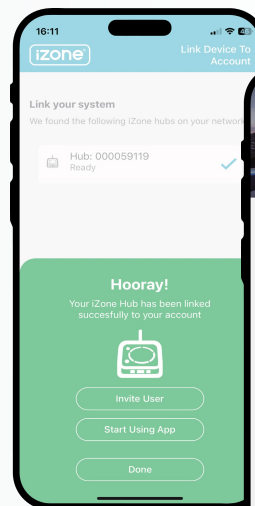
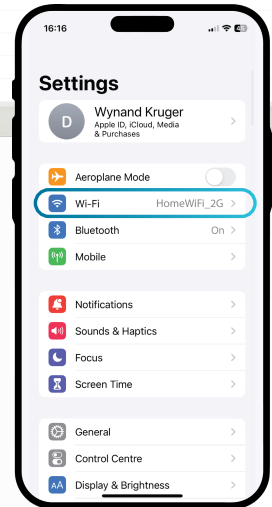
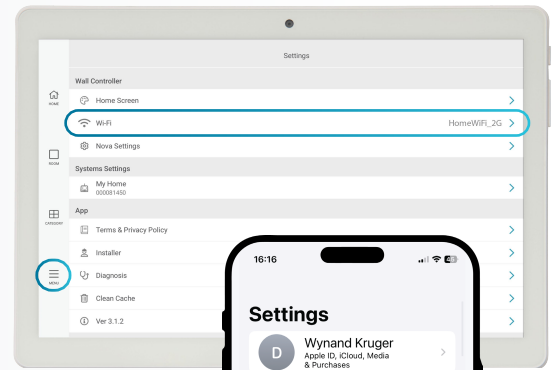


Stage 2: Set Up the iZone Nova Wall Controller

- 1 Tap on Menu
- 2 Tap Settings and Wi-Fi network.
- 3 Ensure the Nova wall controller is connected to the same Wi-Fi network as the Smart Hub.

Stage 3: Set Up the iZone Home App

- 1 **Connect to the Wi-Fi network**
Ensure the Wi-Fi on your mobile device is turned on and connected to the same network as the modem/router linked to your Smart Hub. This connection is essential for the devices to communicate with each other.
- 2 **Download the iZone Home App**
Download the iZone Home app from Google Play (Android) or the App Store (iOS). Allow local network access and notifications so the app can detect your Smart Hub. Follow the on-screen prompts.
- 3 **Start Using the iZone Home app**
If linking is successful, you will see a Hooray! message. At this stage, you can:
 - Invite other household members to control your system by tapping Invite User
 - Skip this step and invite users later.Once done, tap Start *Using App*.
- 4 **View the Home Screen**
The iZone Home app will now display its home screen. If a wall controller has already been installed, you may notice that some devices are pinned and ready to use.
